Key Data

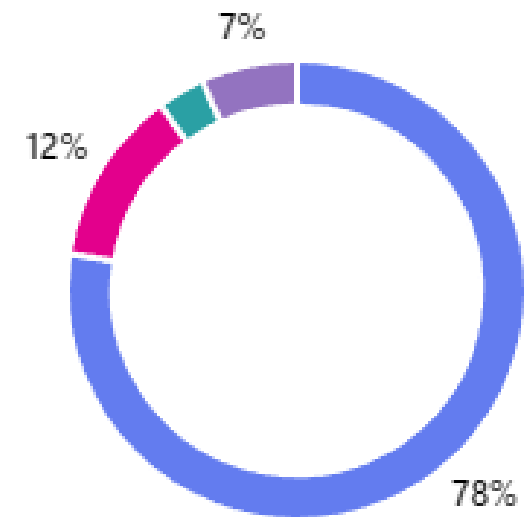
- The most common age group: 14–16 years

- The distribution is even between early-career professionals and those with more than 10 years of experience

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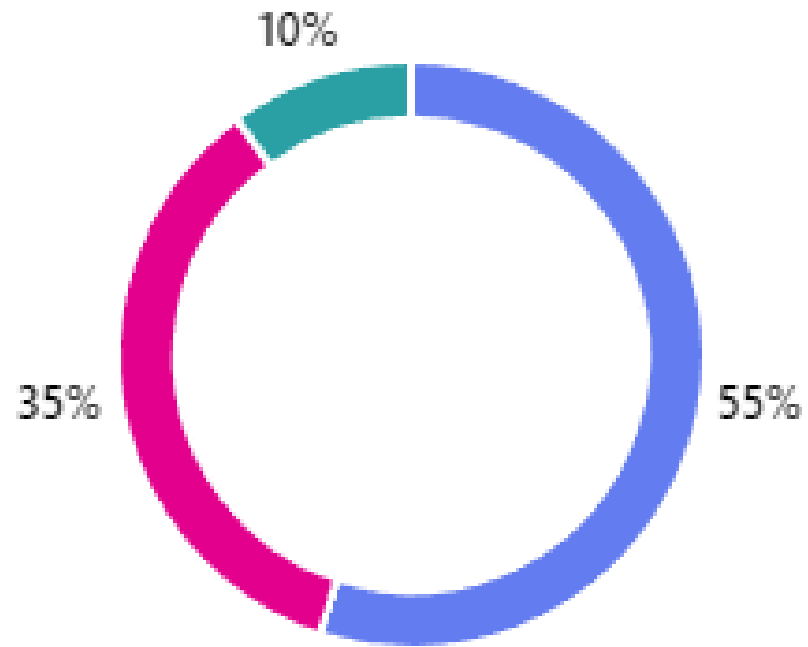
Distribution

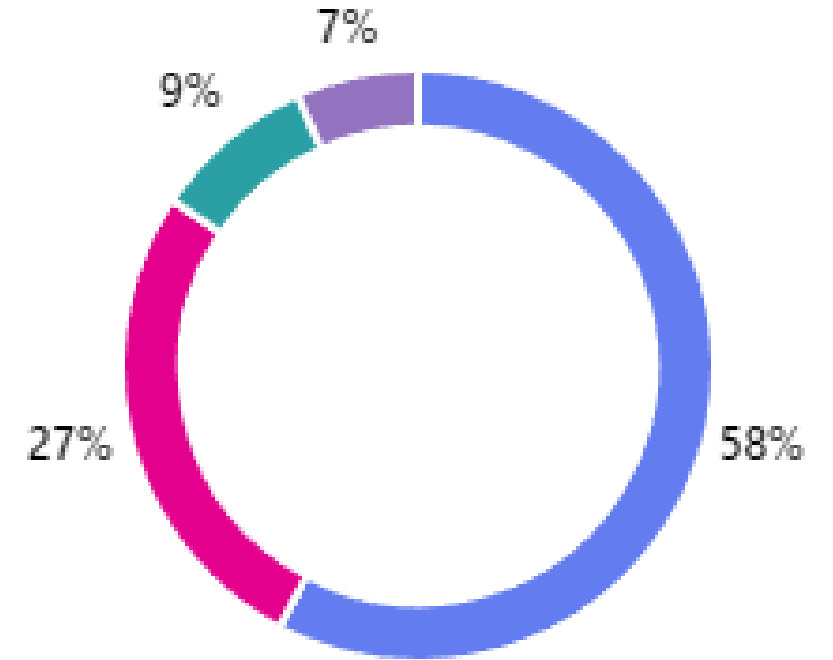


Do you know what an audio podcast is?

How often do you listen to podcasts?



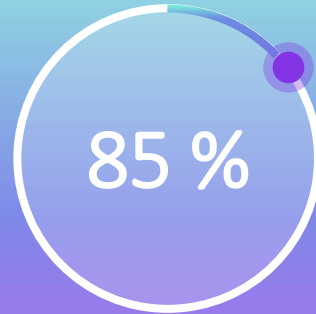
- Never 26

Personal Use?

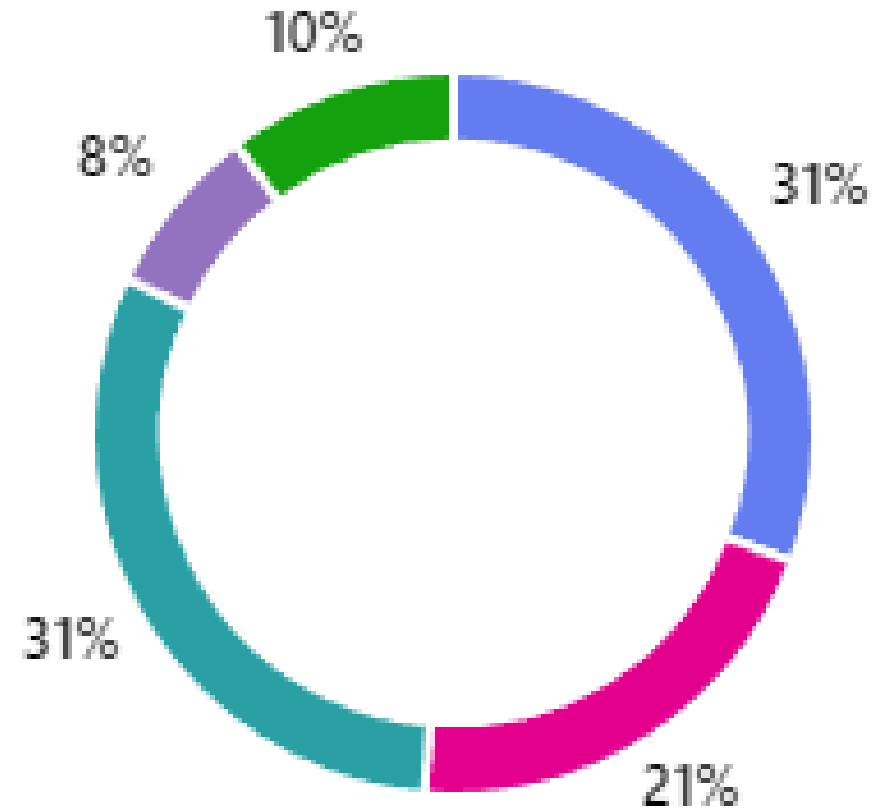
They are willing to implement podcasts as a teaching strategy.
